

**LCFR Volunteer  
Medical Clearance Summary**

Effective July 1, 2011 Loudoun County volunteers are required to pass the NFPA 1582 physical to be an operational firefighter and pass the OSHA physical to be an operational Emergency Medical Technician (EMT). The pre-placement physical is being provided to you at no charge but you are responsible to work with your station representative to complete necessary paperwork, work with Inova to schedule and attend the appointment, and work with your primary physician if follow up documentation is required.

If you are not cleared for duty then you are not authorized to run as an operational volunteer or attend selected training which requires a physical clearance. You will not be covered under worker's compensation or VFIS death and disability as a result of an injury in the act of operational duties if you are not cleared for duty. Additionally, you and your station may be liable for any injury caused to others as a result of an injury in the act of operational duties that you are not cleared to perform.

At your pre-placement physical blood will be drawn for the Hepatitis B titer. You will be notified if your Hepatitis B antibody reading is low and requires you to undergo the Hepatitis B immunization series. OSHA fact sheets regarding Hepatitis B is provided in this packet for your review.

At your pre-placement physical your blood will be drawn for a Tuberculosis (TB) screening to determine if you have been infected or have the TB disease. If your TB screening is positive you will be required to seek a chest x-ray to confirm the reading and possibly medical attention. CDC fact sheet is in the packet for your review.

Local emergency rooms require health care providers to be fully immunized and negative TB reading. Failing these requirements may be a cause for termination as operational status.
